ENTRIES AND COMPETITION FEE

- To register for the invitational competitions (jumps and throws only) send an email to meeting@atleticavicentina.com by Tuesday, July 16th, at 24:00.
- Foreign athletes must submit their registration request via email to meeting@atleticavicentina.com by Tuesday, July 16th, at 24:00.
- Registration is not accepted on the same day as the meeting.
- A €8 registration fee per event is required, payable at the registration desk at the stadium entrance.

ENTRY CONFIRMATION

Each athlete has to validate their entry notification at the registration desk at the stadium entrance **90 minutes before** the start of each event (60 minutes for Hammer Throw).

TECHNICAL INFORMATION

The competition will take place in accordance with FIDAL protocols in force on the meeting date.

RACES Athletes with the best entries will run the last race (with the exception of 100m event).

100m event will have 2 stages: Heats and Final. The best 6 results will advance to the Final.

JUMPS In long/triple-jump the best 8 athletes of the qualification attempts will advance to the Final.

THROWS In throwing events the best 8 athletes of the qualification attempts will advance to the Final.

BIBS Bibs will only be distributed in the Call Room for the 800 races.

IMPLEMENTS Personal implements must be delivered to Technical Management **60**' before each event.

TIMING Timing will be electric and entirely automatic.

CALL-ROOM

20 minutes for track events, 30 minutes for field events and 40 minutes for pole vault.
